Presentations – 2 Featured Speakers

Our first speaker is Rick Copeland, Aquifer Water, a citizen groundwater monitoring program which would like to invite the BFA Membership to monitor private wells monthly. If you or your neighbors have a well on your property, you can help provide important data on saltwater intrusion in our coastal region.

Our next speaker is Ms. Samantha Sexton of the Pew Charitable Trust. Pew works to protect ocean life through conserving marine species and ecosystems. They do this by focusing on promoting sustainable fisheries, safeguarding sensitive marine habitats, and protecting vulnerable marine biodiversity. Learn how you can get involved and how Pew will be helping the BFA with their mission.

Rain Gauge Monitoring Program

Our region experienced a 20+ inch rain event within 48 hours last June (2012). Rain events affect our water quality through stormwater runoff, nutrient loading, and turbidity from erosion or the use of red clay in our riparian zones. To better understand our regional rain events and the impact on our waters, we provided our interested members with a rain gauge and a notebook with instructions. *At this time, we ask you to bring your data so we can develop our regional maps.*
